




# **MISSION**




# **HISTORY**

LIQAA), a لقاء حيّ جنينة اليسوعية (LIQAA), a grassroots initiative, was born from an activist movement in 2013. Ten years ago, it was initiated by active citizens living in the Geitawi neighborhood. They joined together to protect the Jesuit Public Garden from development projects which would have disfigured it. Later, during the 2019 revolution, residents started to meet more regularly, and organized the first community meeting or Sobhyeh in the garden. During the COVID pandemic, residents became disconnected from the community and stress was heightened by the very heavy impact of the Port Blast in 2020. In 2021, active community members created a second petition to prevent another development project in the garden designed without the community's voice. The resurgence of community engagement led to the establishment of LIQAA, with the support of the SEE CHANGE fund, by COSV and OXFAM, in a partnership with Assabil Association, who operates the public library located in the Jesuit Garden. Activities for the community started to be organized in 2023.

# **ACTIVITIES**

The governance of LIQAA is collaborative and participatory and is structured so community members can conceive and lead a variety of activities. This grassroots local initiative is open to any community member, regardless of gender, ethnicity, political affiliation or religion.







After a survey we did in partnership with Assabil Association and the Scouts Groupe de l'Annonciation, LIQAA organized a day to clean the garden with the scouts and other residents. This youth-led event had eco-awareness activities organized by the Scouts, Assabil, and Maya Abou Habib.

Ongoing cleaning was organized by Liqua and financially supported by LIQAA, Assabil and Beit el Baraka from May- December 2023.



### Sobhyeh

In 2023, we had eight Sobhyehs in partnership with Assabil, where community members could talk about community needs, problems and solutions.



### The Walking Club

Launched in March 2023 this weekly sports activity is for all ages. It is led by a trainer and promotes physical health as well as is a social meeting place. A rotating group of 10-20 people join weekly, a majority of which are 55+ women.



## Composting

In partnership with Compost Baladi, Assabil Association and the Beirut Municipality and governorate, LIQAA began composting in the Spring 2023. Two Earth Cubes were donated by Compost Baladi and are being used by 15-30 families to make organic waste into compost.



### Chess

In partnership with Assabil Association, a weekly meetup started in April 2023 takes place in the garden for Chess players of all levels and ages.



#### Jam Session

A Jam session was organized for musicians to play together in February 2023.



## Self-Care Workshop

In partnership with the Anbar Festival and Assabil Association, a workshop on stress with 15-20 participants was led by Nisrine Feghali in March 2023.



# Film Screenings


Film screenings were held in partnership with Assabil Association, Nadi Lekol Nas, Tripoli Film Festival (July 2023) and Anbar Festival (February 2023). Each screening had between 50 to 100 people.

#### Garden Market

With our partners the Municipality of Beirut, Assabil Association and the Scouts Groupe de l'Annonciation, LIQAA successfully launched its first Garden Market on June 23 & 24, 2023

- 3000+ Visitors (neighborhood and outside)
- 31 Vendors (products made in Lebanon or vintage)
- 8 Musical acts (including La chorale eglise de St. Joseph, La Chanterie de Beyrouth, The Beirut Vocal Studio and emerging local talents)
- 3 Eco-workshops (with Refuse, Lebanesecomposters, and Zero Waste Heros)
- 13 Neighborhood vendors
- 17 National vendors
- 4 Food vendors (community initiatives)
